Introduction	PCPV belongs to the family of poxviruses, which includes several members of the virus with economic impact. PCPV has a linear double-stranded DNA genome of 145 kb in length with high GC content and 134 open reading frames (ORFs). The PCPV linear genome contains central and terminal regions. The central region is responsible

e for expressing structural proteins and factors related to viral proliferation while the two terminal regions are closely related to genes related to virulence factors.
